The Dartmoor line is the first route reopened under the Department for Transport's 'Restoring your Railway' initiative.

The line improves access to Exeter St Davids and the national rail network - including Bristol and London - for a wide area including Okehampton, West Devon and North East Cornwall.

In the other direction, Okehampton is a gateway to Dartmoor and will provide a sustainable travel solution for getting to the National Park.

Okehampton Station

We are working with partners to maintain the heritage feel of the station, while providing our customers with the facilities expected of a modern station.



The Station

- The main station building is being renovated with a new café, Dartmoor National Park Visitors Centre, community shop, heritage waiting room and toilet facilities – all scheduled to open in 2022.
- The station will be unstaffed but will be equipped with a card-only ticket machine, CCTV, customer help points and electronic customer information screens.
- The platform used by GWR services will be accessible, with step-free access provided from the street to the platform.



Getting to the Station

On foot: The station is a 15-minute walk from the town centre and sign posted for pedestrians.

By car: Pay and display parking is available at the station, costing £2 a day.

By bus: Bus connections to Okehampton town centre and Tavistock are available from outside the station.

By bike: Cycle parking is available. Note, that space on trains for bikes is limited so we advise leaving bikes securely locked up at the station.

Train Service

The train service will initially run every two hours each way (including early morning) seven days a week, providing huge opportunities for work, study and leisure travel.

Onboard, trains are equipped with free Wi-Fi, plug sockets at every seat and accessible toilet facilities.

Okehampton and Dartmoor National Park



Okehampton station is on the northern edge of Dartmoor National Park and is at the start of The Granite Way, an 11-mile multi-use trail between Okehampton and Lydford. Highlights include Meldon Viaduct, Okehampton Castle (English Heritage) Lydford Gorge (National Trust).

Travelling with Bikes:

We expect the Dartmoor Line to be popular with cyclists. Customers are advised that there is very limited space onboard for bikes. Therefore, we recommend using the local bike hire at the station.

Exeter



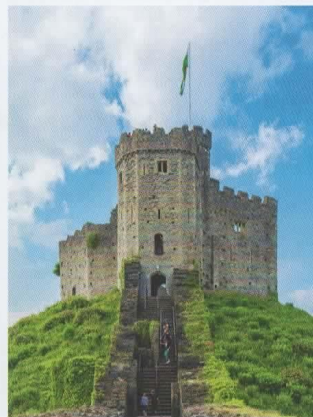
